This role will be responsible for over two billion watts (2GW) of solar production in the Texas region, supervising some of the largest power plants in the United States. This role reports directly to Director of Field Operations.

Description:

The Manager of Field Operations is responsible for project execution across the Texas region. They need to be highly engaged in the day to day operations in the field, but also responsible for continuous learning and improvement. The job responsibilities include:

- Accountable for production and maintenance of all sites in the region
- Primary point of contact for Remote Operations Center and EPC
- Drives warranty compliance and workorder fulfillment
- Manages a diverse and geographically separated staff of services and contractor personnel
- Directs the Safety and Training programs for each site
- Manages new project acquisitions, including hiring, equipping and training personnel
- Accountable for managing project costs
- Establish best practices and identify/manage unique site characteristics
- Identify areas of concern in the project portfolio and strategize to solve issues
- Develop and participate in change management for continuous development of standard operating procedures
- Report out QC results for the region and identify areas of concern / focus

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

- Minimum of 5 years of experience in the energy industry with preference for solar experience
- Leadership experience – must have managed teams of personnel
- Competence in Microsoft products (Excel, PowerPoint, Word), SAP, and Salesforce
- Strong interpersonal and communication skills – able to present and communicate internally and externally to operations groups and leadership
- Ability to help build and strengthen an organization, building structure over time
